Avoiding Communication Mishaps: The Media

- A designated spokesperson should be named who is comfortable dealing with the press and other outside agencies
- All information should flow to and from this person
- This person can be an internal or external
- Never say "no comment"

Avoiding Communication Mishaps: Medical Care

- Are you aware of medical care providers in your area?
- Do you know how many beds these providers have?
- Have you developed a relationship with these providers, and are they included in your response plan or on your team?

Avoiding Communication Mishaps: Parents & Loved Ones

- Emergency contacts if you don't have them, get them
- Communicate with them, do not ignore them
- Let them know where their loved ones are being transported to have someone at the hospital to receive them.

Avoiding Communication Mishaps: Law Enforcement

- Are you certain how they are going to respond?
- Are they familiar with your facilities?
- How is traffic going to be rerouted?

Assemble the Team

- The team is a group of select individuals that can assemble at a moments notice
- Who should be on your team?
 - Law Enforcement
 - Media Consulting Agency
 - Crisis Management
 - Medical Personnel
 - Risk Manager

Assemble the Team

- This team functions as a joint task force, each member responsible for communications for a specific group.
- Each member of the team is responsible for relaying communications to other members of the team for effective coordination of personnel and resources.
- Have the meeting recorded, or have someone take minutes of the meeting

Practice – Practice - Practice

- "Rule of 5s: Fighter pilots achieve "ace" status after five successful dogfights. Parachutists receive their wings after five successful jumps. Experts believe that if five successful reps are attained, one has a 95% chance of success if one encounters an adversary of comparable skill but lacks five successful reps"
- Tabletop exercises are important! Do not set and forget.

Don't Plan in a Vacuum

- Importance and purpose of the team is to involve outside agencies that will play a role should you face an active assailant threat.
- Attempting to "silo" or contain the situation will cause severe constraints on your organizations ability to effectively manage and respond.

Active Assailant Insurance

- Property Damage, Business Interruption, & EE
- Legal Liability
- Loss of attraction & denial of access coverage
- Crisis Management media consulting, counseling, medical services, psychiatric care, etc.
- No exclusion for terrorism

Active Assailant Insurance

- Like any insurance policy, the purpose is risk-transfer
 what risk are you transferring?
- Crisis management/Media consulting are big selling points
- Coverage remains affordable and rates are stable
- Insurance, and how you use it, needs to be included in how you plan to respond
